



SUBJECT PROJECT CONCEPT REPORT

This project is the construction of a sidewalk on the east side of North Main Street from the south side of the Woodstock Library to Ridgewalk Parkway for a total of 0.33 mile. The proposed project will provide clean, functional, aesthetic sidewalks meeting ADA requirements that will encourage pedestrian travel in the area.

The construction proposes to add a 5.5' sidewalk on the east side of North Main Street between the above mentioned limits. A pedestrian bridge (120' long) will span the creek and ravines. Erosion control protection and regrassing and landscaping of all disturbed areas with permanent seed and plants appropriate to the season is included in the project. Traffic will be maintained during construction.

Environmental concerns include requiring a Categorical Exclusion be prepared; a public hearing is not required; time saving procedures are appropriate.

CMAQ PROJECT CONCEPT [DESCRIPTION]:

The project consists of constructing a sidewalk along the east side of North Main Street (also known as Old Highway 5). A pedestrian bridge to span creek and ravines will be constructed. The logical termini begin where the existing sidewalk ends at the south side of the Woodstock Library and continues to the intersection of Ridgewalk Parkway. The project is 0.33 miles in length.

PROPOSED TYPICAL SECTION:

The existing is a two-lane asphalt highway with no curb or gutter except at the entrance to the Woodstock Library. Road width is 24 feet. There is no sidewalk on either side of the road. Proposed is a 5.5-foot wide sidewalk with curb and gutter being placed in front of the Woodstock Library and varying shoulder widths.






