
Recommendations: Recommend that the detour route for the project be approved and that the attached Notice be approved for advertising.

Notice is hereby given that the Georgia Department of Transportation has approved the use of and the routing of a detour for this project.

The date of detour approval is: July 1, 2015

The existing bridge is located on SR 219 over Mountain Oak Creek 1.5 miles south of Whitesville in Harris County. The proposed replacement will be constructed at the same location and tie in with the existing road alignment. The proposed typical section is two 12 ft. lanes with 10 ft. shoulders, 6.5 ft. paved for bikeable shoulder, and the length of the project is 0.4 miles.

The proposed detour utilizes I-185 between exits 25 and 30 for SR 219 traffic. Traveling north on SR 219, the detour begins at the intersection with SR 116. The detour travels east along SR 116 to the interchange with I-185, exit 25. It follows I-185 north for 4.5 miles to the interchange with Hopewell Church Rd, exit 30. The detour turns west along Hopewell Church Rd before ending at the intersection with SR 219.
