your children, the court will enter a judgment ending your rights to your children. parent is not thereafter entitled to notice of proceedings for the adoption of the children by another nor has or she any right to object the adoption or otherwise participate in the proceedings. If the judgment terminates your parental rights, you will no longer have any rights to your children or make any decisions affecting your children or your children's earnings or property. Your children will be legally freed to be adopted by someone else. Even if your parental rights are terminated: (1) You will still be responsible for providing financial support (child support payments) for your children's care unless and until your children are adopted; and (2) Your children can still inherit from you unless and until your children are adopted.
