

SUBJECT Request for Location and Design Approval

Description and Project Proposal:

The proposed project consists of removing the existing 10 foot wide sidewalk along the northern side of SR 112 and eastern side of US 41/SR 7 and replacing with new 10 foot wide imprinted concrete sidewalk within the existing footprint. Planned improvements include the installation of 30 inch curb and gutter, 10 foot wide sidewalks, new street lighting with breakaway design, landscaping, and irrigation to match Phase 1 previously completed. The existing typical section will remain unchanged. The project begins at the intersection of SR 112 and Gordon Street extending west 0.05 miles to the intersection of SR 112 and US 41/SR 7. The project continues at the intersection of US 41 and SR 112 northward on US 41/SR 7 one block or about 0.10 miles to East College Avenue. At the intersection of US 41/SR 7 and East College Ave. the project terminates due to a previously completed streetscape beautification project north of the US 41 and East College Avenue intersection. This project is located in downtown Ashburn, Turner County, Georgia. The proposed project will be approximately 0.15 miles in length.

Notice is hereby given in compliance with Georgia Code 22-2-109 and 32-3-5 that the Georgia Department of Transportation has approved the Location and Design of this project.

The date of location and design approval is: Dec 10, 2013

The proposed project consists of removing the existing 10 foot wide sidewalk along the northern side of SR 112 and eastern side of US 41/SR 7 and replacing with new 10 foot wide imprinted concrete sidewalk within the existing footprint. Planned improvements include the installation of 30 inch curb and gutter, 10 foot wide sidewalks, new street lighting with breakaway design, landscaping, and irrigation to match Phase 1 previously completed. The existing typical section will remain unchanged. The project begins at the intersection of SR 112 and Gordon Street extending west 0.05 miles to the intersection of SR 112 and US 41/SR 7. At the intersection of US 41/SR 7 and East College Ave. the project terminates due to a previously completed streetscape beautification project north of the US 41 and East College Avenue intersection. Pedestrian accessibility will be upgraded to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act. At intersections, painted crosswalks will be improved. This project is located in downtown Ashburn, Turner County. The proposed project will be approximately 0.15 miles in length.
