++Project P.I. No. 0010327++ consists of replacing the four 12-ft travel lanes and intermittent parallel parking along 11 N. McDonough Street with two 11-ft travel lanes and parallel parking on both sides, as feasible. Sidewalks ranging from 5-ft to 10-ft will be constructed on both sides. A bicycle track outside the sidewalk area on the west side of the roadway will be buffered on both sides with a landscape zone to minimize conflicts with pedestrians and vehicles. The project connects to existing bicycle facilities at the south terminus of the project and to a new bicycle facility at Trinity Place at the northern terminus of the project. Based on Detective Howard's training and experience, this type of activity is conducive to illegal narcotics transactions. Detectives were able to follow the female away from the location. Officer Vitar #867 was able to get behind the vehicle and obtain probable cause, a traffic stop was conducted. During the traffic stop, the female driver advised Officer Vitar that she had marijuana on her person. The female relinquished a small blue zip lock bag containing marijuana to Officer Vitar. After further investigation, it was determined through verbal and written statement from the driver that she had purchased the marijuana from the listed location. The substance located during the traffic stop field tested positive for marijuana. After conducting this investigation, Detective Howard responded to the DeKalb Magistrate Court and secured a search warrant.

On November 23, 2011 the DeKalb Narcotics/HDTA Unit and DeKalb Strike Force Unit executed a search warrant at 5668 Tunbridge Wells Rd. Defendant Higgins was located downstairs in what was determined to be his bedroom. Defendant Hayes was located downstairs while his bedroom was determined to be his existing room. Detective Howard was able to determine the rooms belonged to each individual by miscellaneous documents located in each room.

• CAC Bulldog Pug revolver serial #89761 (confirmed stolen out of Atlanta) located inside Defendant Higgins's vehicle
• SKS rifle serial #11081456 located inside Defendant Higgins's vehicle
• SKS rifle serial #1720242 located next to the bed in Defendant Hayes's bedroom
• SKS rifle serial #H242719 located next to the bed in Defendant Higgins's bedroom
• SKS rifle serial #9485346 located inside Defendant Higgins's vehicle
• SKS rifle serial #01443-2000 located inside Defendant Higgins's vehicle

• Intratec sport .22 handgun serial #K004516 located in a closet downstairs
• Multiple gun magazines and bullets located during the search
• Digital scale located on a table in Defendant Hayes's bedroom
