

What started out as a dream just over a year ago has become reality for the Georgia Northwestern Bobcat cheerleaders.

Just before her squad took the court at the Rossville Athletic Center to cheer on the Bobcats' men's basketball team this past Thursday night, head cheer coach Karen Stoker presented each member of the squad with a copy of a letter sent to her on Wednesday from the National Cheerleaders Association (NCA), informing them that they had earned a bid to nationals in Daytona Beach, Florida this April.

The 10-member co-ed squad will compete in Intermediate Division II of the NCA/NDA Collegiate National Championship

against qualifying squads from NCAA Division II and III schools, NAIA schools and other junior and community college schools.

"For our program, this is huge," Stoker beamed. "It's going to help us grow by leaps and bounds. Alex (Smith) and Rhys (Turner) came to me last year after basketball season and said they re-

ally loved cheering at games, but that competition was something they wanted to try and that it was their dream to go to nationals. They even helped recruit the other ones that are here now.

"For those two, it's a once-and-a-lifetime opportunity for two of them. We also have a couple of cheerleaders that will be trying out to cheer

at some four-year schools, so this will look good for them to say, I cheered on a squad that got to compete at NCA Nationals."

The Cheer Cats were selected by the NCA committee after submitting a required video, which showed off their stunting, pyramid and tumbling skills, as well as basket tosses and game-day performances.

The competition

will begin April 8 and run through April 12 and will be televised by CBS Sports Network.

The 2014-2015 Cats Cheer squad includes Selena Dupree, Virgil McCoy, KanDis Perry, Mayvit Sandoval, Sam Shepard, Alex Smith, Alex Tate, Rhys Turner, Katelyn Wallace and manager Tori Brown.
