

**NOTICE OF LOCATION  
AND DESIGN APPROVAL  
P.I. NO. 0011641 WALTON COUNTY**

Notice is hereby given in compliance with Georgia Code 22-2-109 and 32-3-5 that the Georgia Department of Transportation has approved the Location and Design of this project.

The date of location approval is: **January 21, 2015**

The project is located in lots 92, 94, 126 and 128 in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Land District, City of Monroe, Walton County, Georgia. The proposed pedestrian and bicycle improvements extend along North Broad Street approximately 3,115 linear feet (0.59 miles) from 415 feet north of Mayfield Drive to its intersection with West Marable Street. The project is located in the City of Monroe, Walton County, Georgia. The project will construct new or expanded sidewalks along both sides of the corridor using a combination of brick and concrete. In addition, these improvements would include planting street trees and shrubs within a 2' pedestrian buffer zone and a center median, and it would install raised curbs, defined pedestrian crossings and shared lane bicycle markings, pedestrian scale lighting and other street furnishings, and ADA-accessible curb ramps. Concurrent with this work, storm sewer upgrades would be completed with project funding. Improving pedestrian facilities along North Broad Street would facilitate greater connectivity between neighborhood and commercial uses along North Broad Street, as well as the goods and services located in downtown Monroe. Using these two activity nodes as this project's northern and southern termini would provide a stronger, more helpful, linkage to Monroe's historic neighborhoods, and more balanced transportation alternatives for all of North Broad Street's users.
