SUBJECT SR 51 TURN LANE - PROJECT CONCEPT REPORT

This project is the widening of a 0.43 mile section of SR 51 for a two-way center turn lane in Homer. The existing road has a rural section with 24 ft. of pavement and variable width shoulders. Several businesses and a Banks County School Complex are within the project limits. Current and future traffic is 1500 VPD (1990) and 2400 VPD (2010).

The proposed project consists of widening the existing road symmetrically to a total width of 38 ft. to provide for two 12 ft. lanes and a 14 ft. two-way center turn lane. Shoulders will be constructed to a width of 10 ft. The project extends from MP 10.19 to MP 10.62 at the intersection of SR 15/US 441. Access will be controlled by permit. Traffic will be maintained during construction. This project is part of the 1% Roads Program for Banks County and, as such, the Department will fund 100% of engineering, right-of-way and construction costs and the County will fund 100% of utilities costs.
