Powers-Jones is new Ochoopee Library head

Martha Powers-Jones has been hired as the library director for the Ochoopee region, the regional library board announced last week. Powers-Jones has worked with the region since 2006, when she came on as public services librarian and later youth and family services librarian. In January she stepped up as library director upon the resignation of long-term director Dusty Gres.

"We are very excited to have Martha Power-Jones as the new director," said Susanne Gainer, regional board member from Jeff Davis and the chair of the search committee. "Martha has a way of approaching each challenge as an opportunity. Her experience and enthusiasm are a perfect fit for our needs."

Parker Blount, chair of the regional board and a member from Tattnall County, said, "Working very closely with Martha for nearly two months I discovered that she is quick to get to the heart of the problem and come up with workable solutions. She has established exceptionally good relationships with the regional board of trustees, library staff, and members of the community. She has the commitment and the ideas to help all of the libraries

serve their communities better." Powers-Jones is a native of Ohio, where she got her Bachelors of Arts from Ohio Wesleyan University and then her Masters in Library Science from Kent State University. She has worked in libraries since 2001. During her work with the Ochoopee region, she focused on expanding services to underserved communities. She established a Teen Advisory Board, an independent Teen Collection, expanded Spanish collections and bilingual programming, and directed a very popular and successful Summer Reading Program. Powers-Jones is married to Matt Jones, an educator and director of the statewide EmpowerED Georgia, an advocacy group for public education. They live in Lyons.

"As librarians, we must also focus our efforts on meeting the ever-changing needs of our community to retain our viability," said Powers-Jones. "A library's role is to make sure that we are a place where everyone in the community finds value."

"I am thrilled to be working with such a supportive board and with such talented staff members," Powers-Jones said. "Our library system has amazing poten-

tial and I look forward to building on our rich history and working to create a more community-driven library environment."

The Ochoopee region consists of seven libraries in four counties: Toombs (Vidalia, Lyons, and Ladson Genealogical); Tattnall (Reidsville and Glennville); Jeff Davis; and Montgomery. As with most small, rural libraries, these have suffered from declining state funding, with the transformation required by technological advancements; and with a declining focus on lifelong learning.

Everyone in the region is reminded that the library is a public space open to all. Services available include free checkout of books and videos, free computer use, interlibrary loans, use of research materials, audiobooks, ebooks, as well as youth, teen, and adult programs. Computer printing, photocopying, and faxing are also available at most libraries for small fees.

Plan before you plant for a successful summer garden

This time of the year gardeners get excited about their soon-to-be-planted spring vegetable gardens. They envision lush rows of perfect pods of peas, scrumptiously delicious sweet corn and big, beautiful tomatoes. University of Georgia Extension urges gardeners to wait and put some thought and vision into their garden first.

Gardeners should create a garden plan before they order the first packet of seeds or turn the first spade of soil. First, determine how much land you have available, how much time you can spend caring for the garden and the kinds and amounts of vegetables you want to grow.

Where? Next, select for the location of your garden. It's best to put the garden near your home for quick, convenient access. Select a site with a suitable source of water for irrigating on hot, dry summer days. When deciding on a garden site, also remember most vegetables need a lot of sunlight

and perform best in well-drained, fertile soil.

Draw a map of the garden showing the overall dimensions and the number, width, and length of the rows. Next, decide which vegetables (and specific varieties) you want to grow. Note them in your garden plan. (This will help plan next year's garden, too, as UGA experts recommend rotating crop locations to reduce pest pressure.)

Perennial crops, such as asparagus and strawberries, should be planted to one side so they won't interfere with other garden activities. Plant tall crops, like sweet corn, on the north or west side of the garden so they don't shade lower-growing vegetable plants.

Gather your tools No matter how well you plan, it's hard to maintain a garden without the right tools. Plan ahead to have the right equipment on hand. A hoe, rake, spading fork, round-nosed shovel and watering can may be all that's needed to plant and maintain a small garden.

For larger gardens, a rotary tiller or garden tractor might be needed.

During the gardening season, keep detailed records. These records will help you evaluate each variety you grow. Record planting dates and fertilizer applications. Also document rainfall.

It's easy to make changes on paper, but almost impossible to change your garden after it is planted. Carefully plan your garden and follow your plan to help make 2014's vegetable garden the best ever.
