The project would continue east along SR 225 for approximately 460 feet before proceeding north onto new location with new bridge structures of the Coosawattie River. Approximately 0.4 miles after the proposed Coosawattie River Bridge, the project would then tie back into the existing pavement of SR 225 at the intersection of McDaniel Road and SR 225. The proposed project would end approximately 200 feet east of McDaniel Road. The proposed design speed would be 55 mph. The project length is approximately 1.1 miles.

This project is 100% in Gordon County and is in Congressional Districts No. 9 and No. 11. It is located within Land Lots 91, 92, 93, 124, 125, and 126.
