

Notice is hereby given in compliance with Georgia Code 22-2-109 and 32-3-5 that the Georgia Department of Transportation has approved the Location and Design of this project.

The date of location approval is June 28, 2012.

The proposed project would reconstruct the Interchange of I-285 with SR 155/**Flat Shoals** Road in DeKalb County. The project is within Land District #15 and Land Lots 88, 89, 90, 103, 104 & 105.

The work would include construction of a new bridge along SR 155 over I-285. The replacement bridge would provide two through lanes in each direction, bike lanes on both sides, and dual, left-turn lanes from SR 155 northbound and southbound onto I-285 eastbound and westbound. The Interstate Exit Ramps would be widened to provide dual, left-turn and dual, right-turn lanes onto SR 155. The Interstate Entrance Ramps would be widened to provide three lanes at the ramp intersections with SR 155. The lanes would taper down to one lane prior to the ramp nose point with I-285. Walls would be constructed under the Panthersville Road bridge at I-285 to allow the ramps to be extended under the bridge. Noise barriers will be added along I-285, where warranted.
